

Clothing, Food, Special Interest, and Cloverbud 4-H Modeling / Style Revue Narrative Sunday, August 13 @ 6:30 PM in Junior Fair Tent

General Guidelines:

- 1. All 4-H exhibitors enrolled in any 4-H project or Cloverbud may participate in the Modeling Revue.
- 2. Age for each category is determined by 1/1 of current year.
- 3. Items modeled must be from 4-H project work. Projects made outside the 4-H program for school or hobbies are not accepted.
- 4. All Modeling Applications are completed online only and due by August 1, 2023.
- 5. Late applications will NOT be accepted.
- 6. Modeling Applicants should complete applications for each category they wish to model in for that year.

Age Category:

Participants will model based on their 4-H age (not project specific). Participants may model multiple projects but must be from different project areas. For example- participant can model their food project then return to stage for a clothing project. A Participant cannot model two different food projects though in the same year.

Previous winners may not compete in the same age bracket again. Winners are to advance to the next age group. Professional division is for 2023 winners and previous Senior and Professional Division winners.

Age Brackets

- Cloverbud
- First Year: Age 8-11 years old and never competed in any category of modeling. Cloverbud does not count.
- Junior: 9-11 years old
- Intermediate: 12-14 years old
- Senior: 15-18 years old
- Professional 2023 winners and previous Senior and Professional Division winners

The following questions are asked on the online application:

- What are you modeling? (Basic Overview of your project)
- What did you like best about the project?
- One fun thing you did this summer
