

Four FUN things on the Fourth

1. Easter Egg Questions

- Write questions on slips of paper and place in a plastic Easter egg. You just need 5-10 eggs depending on your club size.
- Hand out an egg to different/random members as they enter the meeting and ask them to hold onto it.
- During the meeting, ask the members to open their egg and ask the question aloud. They can pass their egg to another member and have them answer too
- Extra idea – place two pieces of candy in each egg for two volunteers that answer the questions.
- Sample Questions – Give one tip for judging day. What is your favorite 4-H memory? If you could show a “zoo animal” at the fair, what animal would you exhibit? Get creative with your questions!



2. Jelly Bean War

For this game two teams of three will face off at a time. Each team should be on opposite ends of a table. Down the middle of the table should be a line of masking tape. At the start of the game place 20 jelly beans in the center of the table. When the game begins each student will try to move as many jelly beans over to their opponents side of the table. The catch is that they cannot use their hands. Students will move the jelly beans by blowing into a straw. At the end of one minute the team with the least amount of jelly beans on their side is the winner.

4. Turtle Tag

- Choose one person to be IT. Play begins when IT yells, "GO!". IT chases other players.
