

# DUNF FORM

(Drug Use Notification Form)

- It is the LAW (Ohio Revised Code 901-19-06)
- DUNFs are required of the following species: Market: Steer, Hog, Lamb, Dairy Steer, Goat, Poultry (by pen), Veal Calf, Lactating Dairy Cattle and Dairy Goats
- No person shall submit an incomplete, illegible or unsigned DUNF
- If the DUNF is incomplete, the exhibitor shall correct / complete the form prior to: receiving any prizes or awards for that exhibit; or participating in the show or sale

## Things to look for...

- DUNF must be complete and legible
- DUNF must be turned into a Senior Fairboard member at their specie's at weigh in time – **Animals will not be able to be weighed until the DUNF is turned in**
- A form is needed for **each animal** not specie - if you have two market hogs then exhibitors must have two completed forms.

**Exhibition/Fair Name:** Mercer County

**2 Digit Fair Code:** 45

**Section 1 & 2** - Complete fully

**Section 3** - Must include official tag number - farm or personal tags are not acceptable

**Section 4** - One form for each specie

**Section 5** - Personal animal name is not acceptable

**Section 6** - **EVERY** exhibitor should mark yes

**Section 7** -

- ✓ You will mark just one box –
  - Yes free from medication (box 1) **or** No, not free from medication (box 2)
- ✓ If your animal is currently is not free from medication, you must complete each part of the chart describing the medication
- ✓ Veterinarian information must be provided – **Client Patient Relationship**
- ✓ Withdraw Completion Date - must be before that specie's market show at Mercer County Fair

**Section 8** - All exhibitors need to sign verifying the information on the form

**Section 9** - All parents must sign verifying the information on the form. It is even best practice for those members over the age of 18
