- Intermediate level. State fair eligible.


544 Ready, Set, ... Mow!

Quality Assurance Requirement

What is QA? The QA program is intended to provide information and knowledge surrounding the quality and care of livestock for 4-H and FFA members. It is mandated by OSU and ODA is a Jr. Fair requirement.

Who needs to attend? All livestock members exhibiting a market animal (large and small) must attend a training or test out option if age eligible.

Quality Assurance Training Options:

More information regarding QA will be mailed and emailed to members after the March 1st deadline. Please be sure to mark these dates on your calendar in the meantime.




