### **Project Interviews/Judging**

Project interviews are only a few weeks away! Hopefully by now you are putting the finishing touches on your projects and preparing for your interviews.

Completing project judging is large part of being a 4-H member. The process of sharing the experiences and knowledge learned completing projects happens at judging. There are qualified and knowledgeable judges ready to listen and help members grow in interview skills. It is crucial that families make every effort to attend their scheduled interview day and have their members prepared. *Interviews* (judging) are the "game day" for 4-H members.

We understand that some circumstances may not allow members to attend regular scheduled project judging. A Final Judging event will be held on July 25<sup>th</sup> from 9:00-4:00 at the Extension Office. You must call the Extension Office at 419-586-2179 to schedule an appointment. Limited time slots available. *Members who attend this option do not qualify for state fair selection or trophy awards.*

### Jr. Fair Premiums

Premiums will be paid out to 4H and FFA exhibitors during the week of the fair. A staff member will be in the Junior Fair Office, located in the Kenn-Feld Community Center, Saturday, August 12, through Wednesday, August 16, from 9-11 AM, and then again from 4-6pm. Premiums will be paid out in the form of cash and will <u>ONLY</u> be distributed during these time frames. **Premiums will only** be distributed to the <u>exhibitors or a legal guardian.</u>

Every member completing a project judging interview (livestock, non livestock and cloverbuds) will receive a \$5 premium. There is \$25 cap for 4-H projects and a \$25 cap for FFA projects. This means - if you complete a dairy interview, you will earn \$5. It does not matter the number of entries for dairy classes or if you are selling in the auction. If you complete a dairy interview and a woodworking project judging, then you will earn \$10.
