

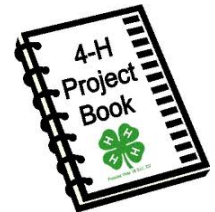
# You Have Chosen a Shooting Sports Project... Now What?

## 1. Get your project book and review the Project Requirements

- Be sure to review the project completion, county, and state requirements. The link to this document can be found on the front of your project book or at <http://go.osu.edu/ProgramRequirements>.
- Visual Display is required for Shooting Sports Project. This could be a tri-fold poster, scrapbook, or any other way to display the information learned. Ensure that pictures and explanation of the completed project are included.

## 2. Filling out your Book

- Complete the project book including learning experiences and citizen/leadership experiences.
- All Shooting Sports Discipline books are required to have a signature from a certified 4-H Shooting Sports instructor before judging. This does not include Basic Archery or Safe Use of Guns projects. Further details will be shared with times and dates to have this completed.



## 3. Practice Judging

- Member should prepare a “little speech” about their project. Members may find it easier to share their findings rather than being asked questions by the judge. Things to keep in mind:
  - What were your goals this year?
  - What did you do or make to reach those goals?
  - What did you learn?
  - What was the biggest challenge you faced?
  - What would you do differently?



## 4. Judging Day

- Members will be assigned a judging time for their project. This will be posted on Mercer County Extension Website and reviewed by advisors
- Report 10 minutes early for your judging time with all your project materials including your book!
- Make sure you know your 4-H age, club name, judge number, and project.

## 5. Fair

- All projects will be proudly displayed in the club booths inside the Junior Fair Building. Your advisor will determine this process for your club.
- Members should review the schedule for picking up their premiums (\$5) during the fair.
- Members will receive a letter in the mail if they qualify for a trophy or state fair.
- Members may earn an Outstanding or Best in Class ribbon and this will be displayed in their booth with their project.
